

Things To Bring to Second Bankruptcy Meeting

1. Driver's License
 2. Social Security Card
 3. Federal and State Tax Returns- Last two years including 09' if you have filed them
 4. Last six months of recent pay stubs showing year to date income. Or YTD profit and loss statement if you own your own business. If you had more than one employer throughout the year, need total year to date income.
 5. Information on any Unemployment Benefits Received
 6. Information on any Social Security Benefits Received
 7. 401k Statement and/or Pension/Retirement Information
 8. Deeds to All Real Property
 9. Recorded Mortgage- (get from Register of Deeds)
 10. Recorded Second Mortgage (home equity loans)
 11. Pay off letter from Mortgage Company and Second Mortgage Company
 12. Recent Tax Bill showing SEV of any Real Property you own or are purchasing
 13. Titles to all Vehicles, Motor Cycles, Mobile Homes/ ORV's
 14. Proofs of Insurance on All Assets Insured.
 15. Statements or information containing the name, address, account number, type of account and balance due (including deficiency balances for repossessed items) regarding any and all entities or private parties you owe money to including Taxes, Student Loans, Credit Card Companies, Banks, Mortgage Companies, Hospitals, Doctors, Lawyers, Department Stores, Auto Companies, Phone Companies, Computer Companies, Furniture Stores, Gas Companies (Shell, Mobil, BP) Fitness Centers, Friends, and Family.
 16. Collections Letters
 17. Copies of any Lawsuits, Judgments, Garnishments in which you party or were a party in the last two years including Judgments of Divorce.
 18. Name and address of any co-makers/ co-debtors on any of your debts. If you cosigned on a debt for someone else, the name and address of that creditor.
 19. List of All Regular Bills/ Expenses (rent/mortgage, utilities, insurance, groceries, etc.) See list attached
 20. List of All Assets/Furniture/Belongings with resale values. See attached list of House Hold Goods
